



MUTUAL RECOGNITION AGREEMENT

AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS

and

INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS SRI LANKA

The Australian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (AIQS) and the Institute of Quantity Surveyors Sri Lanka (IQSSL) have agreed to enter into a Mutual Recognition Agreement for the mutual benefit of their members and to strengthen the relationship between both organisations.

In achieving this, AIQS and IQSSL recognise equivalency in each other's membership entry and advancements standards (educational and professional), and agree;

1. That a corporate member (Associate, Member or Fellow) of the IQSSL may be elected as a Member or Fellow of the AIQS subject to:
 - (a) Provision of a CPD Compliance Certificate from IQSSL
 - (b) Having no outstanding complaints
 - (c) Being a fully financial member of IQSSL
 - (d) Satisfactory completion of a professional interview by AIQS.
2. That a corporate member (Associate, Member or Fellow) of the AIQS may be elected as an Associate, Member or Fellow of the IQSSL subject to:
 - (a) Provision of a CPD Compliance Certificate from AIQS
 - (b) Having no outstanding complaints
 - (c) Being a fully financial member of AIQS
 - (d) Satisfactory completion of an Assessment of Professional Competence interview by corporate members of IQSSL.
3. That each party will notify the other party of any proposed merger or major constitutional change affecting membership entry and advancement.
4. That both organisations will work toward establishing frameworks for achieving common goals across the areas of education, professionalism, technical Standards, and membership, for the betterment of members of both Institutes.
5. This Mutual Recognition Agreement will remain in force for a period of five years from the date of signing.
